Formed in 1988 by six San Francisco Bay Area sculptors,

the Pacific Rim Sculptors Group (PRSG) was created to establish a new forum for sculptors to meet, exchange ideas, and exhibit their work.

Currently there are more than 150 artist members throughout Northern and Central California. With a mission that hinges on the statement that "cultural vitality and artistic diversity contribute to a healthy society," this group also works to "increase public awareness of sculpture by promoting public and private sculpture exhibits, education, resource, and outreach programs."

Selections from the Pacific Rim Sculptors Group serves to provide ICA visitors with an opportunity to experience a wide variety of sculpture from throughout the region. The exhibition includes the work of 15 artists, selected from nearly 400 submissions. The artists are Ed Clapp, Teresa Cunniff, Pam Dernham, Sara Gordon, Peter Hiers, Jane Johnson, Mary King, Nancy Nodelman, Paulette Peterson, Laurie Polster, Susan Steinman, Gina Telcocci, Marta Thoma, Ellen Vogel, and Ann Weber.
